The contest provides the opportunity for students to participate in an educational activity about the surprising peacock habitat and interspecies coexistence here in Palos Verdes.

PRIZE AWARDS

Five winners will be chosen in each division. The winners and their parents will be honored at a party at the Malaga Cove Library on April 30, 2011.

Prizes include autographed copies of the book *The Peacocks of Palos Verdes*, Gift Certificates from Terranea Resort, Small Wonders, peacock wristbands from Friends of the Peacocks, drawings, prizes from Nantucket Crossing and bird seed from The Wild Bird Store.

Winners will be invited to ride on a Peacock Float in the 2011 Rolling Hills Estates Christmas Parade.

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES AND GUIDELINES

- The poster contest will be conducted in three divisions: Primary, Middle and Upper.
- Each student must submit one poster that shows peacock behavior and/or habits in our community.
- Each poster must have an entry form, title and poster description. Only one entry per student.
- Posters should be standard size (11" x 14") poster paper.
- Posters may be in color or black and white, in whatever medium the entrant chooses (i.e. pastels, watercolors, markers, pencils, chalk etc.).
- Entries will be judged on the following criteria: creativity, relevance to the theme, content and layout/design.
- The library reserves the right to display the posters.
- You may turn your entry into any Palos Verdes Library by April 16th.
